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ABSTRACT

**MULTIDISCIPLINARY APPROACH FOR AN ESTHETIC
SMILE REHABILITATION**

Patients who are coming for the consultation often have esthetic problems that can be solved only with limited prosthetic treatment, but when the cosmetic damage is more complex in nature, the clinician will be responsible for explaining to the patients that the solution to his problem goes through a more comprehensive rehabilitation treatment.

The resolution of these complex cases in dental surgery often requires the integration of new technologies and the investment of many different disciplines.

Planning the outcome and objectives is essential to improve communication between the different treatment stakeholders. Different planning tools associated with different surgical, prosthetic and orthodontic techniques allow us to offer the most reliable but also the most conservative treatment.

The course of treatment must therefore be chosen with the various specialists, such as orthodontists, endodontists, periodontists, implantologists, prosthetists, of course with an esthetic perspective but also respecting the biological and functional environment.

Proper planning will then allow us to optimize, while being more less invasive surgical treatment, and more conservative with our prosthesis or by using also all that digital flow allows us to achieve.
